

Cause-and-Effect Toys

PROBLEM SOLVING | Ages 6-12 months | 18 minutes

About This Activity

Introduce toys that respond to baby's actions, teaching cause-effect relationships.

Materials Needed

- pop up toy
- musical toys
- stacking cups
- balls

Step-by-Step Instructions

Offer toys where baby's action causes something to happen: pop-up toys, musical toys with buttons, stacking cups that crash down, balls that roll. Show baby once, then let them explore. Narrate: 'You pushed the button and music played!' This teaches logic and problem-solving. 15-20 minutes.
