Step-by-Step Instructions

Provide dress-up clothes: hats, scarves, old clothes, costumes. Encourage role-playing: doctor, firefighter, parent, teacher. Join in! Ask questions about their pretend scenario. This develops imagination, language, social skills, and understanding of the world. 20-30 minutes.
