

# Interactive Storytelling

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## About This Activity

Tell stories together where child helps narrate, building narrative skills and imagination.

## Materials Needed

- puppets
- toy figures
- story books

## Step-by-Step Instructions

Start a simple story: 'Once upon a time, there was a little...' and let child fill in details. Ask questions: 'What happened next?' 'Where did they go?' Use toys or puppets to act out stories. This builds language, sequencing, and creativity. 15-20 minutes.
