

Puzzle Solving (4-12 pieces)

PROBLEM SOLVING | Ages 24-36 months | 15 minutes

About This Activity

Work on age-appropriate puzzles to develop problem-solving and spatial reasoning.

Materials Needed

- wooden puzzles
- jigsaw puzzles

Step-by-Step Instructions

Start with 4-6 piece wooden puzzles with knobs. Gradually progress to 8-12 piece puzzles. Help child by pointing out colors, shapes, and where pieces might go. Let them try first before offering help. Completing puzzles builds spatial reasoning, patience, and problem-solving. 10-15 minutes.
