About This Activity

Practice social skills like sharing toys and taking turns through simple games.

Materials Needed

- toys
- simple board games

Step-by-Step Instructions

Play simple games that require turn-taking: rolling a ball, building blocks together, simple board games. Say 'My turn, your turn.' Model sharing: 'I'll play with the red car, you play with the blue car.' Praise sharing and turn-taking. These skills are hard for toddlers but crucial for social development. 15-20 minutes.
